ALL STUDENTS:

- 1 Backpack
- 1 water bottle
- 1 set of headphones (not earbuds!)
- Extra set of clothing (accidents happen!)
- 1 Lunchbox if needed OR check with the school if your student is eligible for Free and Reduced School Meals

Kindergarten:

- 1 pack of 12 pencils
- 2 boxes of crayons
- 12 purple glue sticks
- 1 pack of washable markers
- 4 black dry-erase markers
- 1 blue plastic 3-prong folder with pockets
- 1 backpack (large enough to fit a folder, lunchbox, and a snack)
 *Please NO backpacks with wheels
- 1 pair of Headphones labeled with your child's name- No Earbuds
- 1 primary lined composition book
- 1 package of Play Dough
